AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE VILLAGE OF METTAWA CODE OF ORDINANCES WITH RESPECT TO FEES, FINES AND PENALTIES

WHEREAS, the Village of Mettawa has established fines and penalties for violations of certain provisions of the Village of Mettawa Code of Ordinances; and

WHEREAS, the President and Board of Trustees find it to be in the best interests of the Village and its residents to amend the provisions of the Mettawa Code of Ordinances to consolidate within one Article the provisions related to fines and penalties, as set forth in this ordinance;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Mettawa, Lake County, Illinois, in the exercise of its home rule powers, as follows:

SECTION 1: The Mettawa Code of Ordinances, Chapter 5, Streets and Parks, Article X, Administration and Enforcement, Section 5.1004, Penalties for Misdemeanor, Subsection B is hereby amended and as amended shall read as follows:

SECTION 5.1004 Penalties for Misdemeanor

B. Any person who violates any provisions of this Chapter shall be fined as set forth in Chapter 2, Village Government, Article X, Fines and Penalties, Section 2.1002, Fines and Penalties Schedule. Each and every day during or on which a violation occurs or continues to exist shall constitute a separate offense.

SECTION 2: The Mettawa Code of Ordinances, Chapter 6, Traffic Code, Article II, Obedience to and Effect of Traffic Laws, Section 6.204, Fleeing or Attempting to Elude Police Officer, Subsection A is hereby amended and as amended shall read as follows:

SECTION 6.204 Fleeing or Attempting to Elude Police Officer

A. Any driver or operator of a motor vehicle who, having been given a visual or audible signal by a peace officer directing such driver or operator to bring his vehicle to a stop, willfully tails or refuses to obey such direction, increases his speed, extinguishes his lights, or otherwise flees or attempts to elude the officer is guilty of a misdemeanor and shall be fined as set forth in Chapter 2, Village Government, Article X, Fines and Penalties, Section 2.1002, Fines and Penalties Schedule.

SECTION 3: The Mettawa Code of Ordinances, Chapter 6, Traffic Code, Article III, Traffic Signs, Signals and Markings, Section 6.303, Interference with Official Traffic Control Devices or Railroad Signs or Signals, Subsection B is hereby amended and as amended shall read as follows:

SECTION 6.303 Interference with Official Traffic Control Devices or Railroad Signs or Signals

B. Any person failing to comply with Subsection A of this Section shall upon conviction be fined as set forth in Chapter 2, Village Government, Article X, Fines and Penalties, Section 2.1002, Fines and Penalties Schedule.

SECTION 4: The Mettawa Code of Ordinances, Chapter 6, Traffic Code, Article III, Traffic Signs, Signals and Markings, Section 6.304, Unlawful Use or Damage to Highways, Appurtenances and Structures, Subsection B is hereby amended and as amended shall read as follows:

SECTION 6.304 Unlawful Use or Damage to Highways, Appurtenances and Structures

B. Any person failing to comply with Subsection A of this Section shall upon conviction be fined as set forth in Chapter 2, Village Government, Article X, Fines and Penalties, Section 2.1002, Fines and Penalties Schedule.

SECTION 5: The Mettawa Code of Ordinances, Chapter 6, Traffic Code, Article IV, Accidents, Section 6.401 Accidents Involving Death or Personal Injuries, Subsections C and D are hereby amended and as amended shall read as follows:

SECTION 6.401 Accidents Involving Death or Personal Injuries

C. Any person failing to comply with Subsection A of this Section shall upon conviction be fined as set forth in Chapter 2, Village Government, Article X, Fines and Penalties, Section 2.1002, Fines and Penalties Schedule.

D. Any person failing to comply with Subsection B of this Section shall upon conviction be fined as set forth in Chapter 2, Village Government, Article X, Fines and Penalties, Section 2.1002, Fines and Penalties Schedule.

SECTION 6: The Mettawa Code of Ordinances, Chapter 6, Traffic Code, Article IV, Accidents, Section 6.402, Accidents Involving Damage to Vehicle, Subsection B is hereby amended and as amended shall read as follows:

SECTION 6.402 Accidents Involving Damage to Vehicle

B. Any person failing to comply with Subsection A of this Section shall upon conviction be fined as set forth in Chapter 2, Village Government, Article X, Fines and Penalties, Section 2.1002, Fines and Penalties Schedule.

SECTION 7: The Mettawa Code of Ordinances, Chapter 6, Traffic Code, Article IV, Accidents, Section 6.403, Duty to Give Information and Render Aid, Subsection C is hereby amended and as amended shall read as follows:

SECTION 6.403 Duty to Give Information and Render Aid

C. Any person failing to comply with Subsection A of this Section shall upon conviction be fined as set forth in Chapter 2, Village Government, Article X, Fines and Penalties, Section 2.1002, Fines and Penalties Schedule.

SECTION 8: The Mettawa Code of Ordinances, Chapter 6, Traffic Code, Article IV, Accidents, Section 6.404, Duty Upon Damaging Unattended Vehicle or Other Property, Subsection B is hereby amended and as amended shall read as follows:

B. Any person failing to comply with Subsection A of this Section shall upon conviction be fined as set forth in Chapter 2, Village Government, Article X, Fines and Penalties, Section 2.1002, Fines and Penalties Schedule.

SECTION 9: The Mettawa Code of Ordinances, Chapter 6, Traffic Code, Article IV, Accidents, Section 6.409, False Reports, is hereby amended and as amended shall read as follows:

SECTION 6.409 False Reports

Any person who provides information in an oral or written report required by this Article with knowledge or reason to believe that the information is false, shall, upon conviction, be fined as set forth in Chapter 2, Village Government, Article X, Fines and Penalties, Section 2.1002, Fines and Penalties Schedule.

SECTION 10: The Mettawa Code of Ordinances, Chapter 6, Traffic Code, Article V, Reckless Driving, Section 6.503, Reckless Driving, Subsection B, is hereby amended and as amended shall read as follows:

SECTION 6.503 Reckless Driving

B. Every person convicted of reckless driving shall be punished upon conviction by a fine as set forth in Chapter 2, Village Government, Article X, Fines and Penalties, Section 2.1002, Fines and Penalties Schedule.

SECTION 11: The Mettawa Code of Ordinances, Chapter 6, Traffic Code, Article V, Reckless Driving, Section 6.504, Drag Racing, is hereby amended and as amended shall read as follows:

SECTION 6.504 Drag Racing

Any person who, as an operator of a motor vehicle, is convicted of being a participant in drag racing shall be punished upon conviction by a fine as set forth in Chapter 2, Village Government, Article X, Fines and Penalties, Section 2.1002, Fines and Penalties Schedule.

SECTION 12: The Mettawa Code of Ordinances, Chapter 6, Traffic Code, Article VII, Driving on Right Side of Roadway; Overtaking and Passing, Section 6.712, Approaching, Overtaking, and Passing School Bus, Subsection A.1. is hereby repealed.

SECTION 13: The Mettawa Code of Ordinances, Chapter 6, Traffic Code, Article XIII, Stopping, Standing and Parking, Section 6.1305, Lessors of Visitor Vehicles; Duty upon Receiving Notice of Violation of Parking Regulations, Subsection B is hereby amended and as amended shall read as follows:

SECTION 6.1305 Lessors of Visitor Vehicles; Duty upon Receiving Notice of Violation of Parking Regulations

B. A person who violates any provisions of this Section, shall be fined as set forth in Chapter 2, Village Government, Article X, Fines and Penalties, Section 2.1002, Fines and Penalties Schedule.

SECTION 14: The Mettawa Code of Ordinances, Chapter 6, Traffic Code, Article XIII, Stopping, Standing and Parking, Section 6.1317, Penalty, Subsection E. is hereby amended and as

amended shall read as follows:

SECTION 6.1317 Penalty

E. The violation described in said citation issued pursuant to the terms of this Article, may be settled, compromised and paid in the respective amounts set forth in the schedule as set forth in Chapter 2, Village Government, Article X, Fines and Penalties, Section 2.1002, Fines and Penalties Schedule.

SECTION 15: The Mettawa Code of Ordinances, Chapter 6, Traffic Code, Article XIV, Miscellaneous Laws, Section 6.1414, Approaching and Overtaking a School Bus, Subsection A.1. is hereby amended and as amended shall read as follows:

SECTION 6.1414 Approaching and Overtaking a School Bus, Subsection A.1.

A.1. Any person convicted of violating this Section, upon conviction, shall be fined as set forth in Chapter 2, Village Government, Article X, Fines and Penalties, Section 2.1002, Fines and Penalties Schedule.

SECTION 16: The Mettawa Code of Ordinances, Chapter 6, Traffic Code, Article XIV, Miscellaneous Laws, Section 6.1424, Driver and Passenger Required to Use Safety Belts; Exceptions and Penalty, Subsection D. is hereby amended and as amended shall read as follows:

SECTION 6.1424 Driver and Passenger Required to Use Safety Belts; Exceptions and Penalty

D. A violation of this Section shall be a petty offense and subject to a fine as set forth in Chapter 2, Village Government, Article X, Fines and Penalties, Section 2.1002, Fines and Penalties Schedule.

SECTION 17: The Mettawa Code of Ordinances, Chapter 6, Traffic Code, Article XVI, Bicycles, Section 6.1622, Penalties, is hereby amended and as amended shall read as follows:

SECTION 6.1622 Penalties

Any person found guilty of violating any provision of this Article shall be punished by a fine as set forth in Chapter 2, Village Government, Article X, Fines and Penalties, Section 2.1002, Fines and Penalties Schedule.

SECTION 18: The Mettawa Code of Ordinances, Chapter 6, Traffic Code, Article XVII, Regulation of Commercial Traffic, Section 6.1701, Operation of Certain Vehicles Prohibited, Subsection C.1. is hereby amended and as amended shall read as follows:

SECTION 6.1701 Operation of Certain Vehicles Prohibited

C.1. Any person, firm, or corporation who or which violates, disobeys, neglects, fails to comply with, or resists enforcement of, the provisions of this Section shall be fined as set forth in Chapter 2, Village Government, Article X, Fines and Penalties, Section 2.1002, Fines and Penalties Schedule.

SECTION 19: The Mettawa Code of Ordinances, Chapter 6, Traffic Code, Article XIX,

Construction, Penalties and Disposition of Fines, Section 6.1905, Penalties for Misdemeanor, Subsection B is hereby amended and as amended shall read as follows:

SECTION 6.1905 Penalties for Misdemeanor

B. A person who violates any provisions of this Section, shall be fined as set forth in Chapter 2, Village Government, Article X, Fines and Penalties, Section 2.1002, Fines and Penalties Schedule.

SECTION 20: The Mettawa Code of Ordinances, Chapter 7, Offenses and Miscellaneous Regulations, Article II, Anti-Litter Regulations, Section 7.218, Penalty, is hereby amended and as amended shall read as follows:

SECTION 7.218 Anti-Litter Regulations

Whoever violates any of the provisions of this Article shall be subject to the penalties as set forth in Chapter 2, Village Government, Article X, Fines and Penalties, Section 2.1002, Fines and Penalties Schedule.

SECTION 21: The Mettawa Code of Ordinances, Chapter 7, Offenses and Miscellaneous Regulations, Article III, Dutch Elm Disease, Section 7.305, Penalty, is hereby amended and as amended shall read as follows:

SECTION 7.305 Penalty

Any person, firm or corporation violating any provision(s) of this Article by failing, neglecting or refusing to comply with the provisions of any notice herein provided for, within thirty (30) days after the service thereof, or, who shall resist or obstruct the Building and Zoning Director, or his duly authorized representative, in carrying out the provisions of this Article, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor punishable by a fine as set forth in Chapter 2, Village Government, Article X, Fines and Penalties, Section 2.1002, Fines and Penalties Schedule. Each day such violation is committed or permitted to continue shall constitute a separate offense and shall be punishable as such hereunder.

SECTION 22: The Mettawa Code of Ordinances, Chapter 7, Offenses and Miscellaneous Regulations, Article VII, Solicitors and Canvassers, Section 7.711, Penalty, is hereby amended and as amended shall read as follows:

SECTION 7.711 Penalty

Every person convicted of a violation of any provision of this Article shall be punished by a fine as set forth in Chapter 2, Village Government, Article X, Fines and Penalties, Section 2.1002, Fines and Penalties Schedule.

SECTION 23: The Mettawa Code of Ordinances, Chapter 7, Offenses and Miscellaneous Regulations, Article X, Fireworks, Section 7.1003, Penalties, is hereby amended and as amended shall read as follows:

SECTION 7.1003 Penalties

Upon conviction: Any person who violates the provisions of Section 7.1001 of this Article shall be

fined as set forth in Chapter 2, Village Government, Article X, Fines and Penalties, Section 2.1002, Fines and Penalties Schedule. Each day that a violation of the provisions of said Section 7.1001 exists shall constitute a separate violation. The foregoing notwithstanding, any person found to be in violation of this Article shall relinquish all fireworks in his possession to the Lake County Sheriff's Police for destruction.

SECTION 24: The Mettawa Code of Ordinances, Chapter 7, Offenses and Miscellaneous Regulations, Article XI, Video Gaming, Section 7.1102, Violations; Penalties, Subsection A. is hereby amended and as amended shall read as follows:

SECTION 7.1102 Violations; Penalties

A. Upon conviction: Any person who violates the provisions of Section 7.1101 of this Article shall be fined as set forth in Chapter 2, Village Government, Article X, Fines and Penalties, Section 2.1002, Fines and Penalties Schedule, for each and every offense, depending upon the frequency of the violations; and each day that a violation of the provisions of said Section 7.1101 exists shall constitute a separate violation.

SECTION 25: The Mettawa Code of Ordinances, Chapter 7, Offenses and Miscellaneous Regulations, Article XIII, Unpaid Charges and Assessments and Disclosure of Interests, Section 7.1303, Violation; Penalty, Subsection A. is hereby amended and as amended shall read as follows:

SECTION 7.1303 Violation; Penalty

A. Every person convicted of a violation of any of the provisions on this Section shall be punished by a fine as set forth in Chapter 2, Village Government, Article X, Fines and Penalties, Section 2.1002, Fines and Penalties Schedule.

SECTION 26: The Mettawa Code of Ordinances, Chapter 8, Private Individual Onsite Sewage Disposal Systems, Article XIV, Sanctions, Section 8.1401, Violations; Penalty, Subsection B. is hereby amended and as amended shall read as follows:

B. Any person, firm, or corporation who violates, disobeys, refuses to comply with, or who resists enforcement of any of the provisions of this Chapter shall be subject to a fine as set forth in Chapter 2, Village Government, Article X, Fines and Penalties, Section 2.1002, Fines and Penalties Schedule, for each offense. For purposes of this Section and this Chapter, each day that a violation is permitted to exist shall constitute a separate offense.

SECTION 27: The Mettawa Code of Ordinances, Chapter 9, Building Code, Article XV, Occupancy Certificate; Penalties, Section 9.1505, Penalties and Unlawful Continuance, Subsections A.2. and B.2. are hereby amended and as amended shall read as follows:

SECTION 9.1505 Penalties and Unlawful Continuance

A.2. Upon conviction thereof, any Person who has undertaken any of the unlawful acts listed in the above Paragraph 1 of this Subsection A of this Section 9.1505 shall be subject to fines as set forth in Chapter 2, Village Government, Article X, Fines and Penalties, Section 2.1002, Fines and Penalties Schedule, for each offense. Each day that a violation continues shall be a separate offense.

B.2. Upon conviction thereof, any Person who has undertaken any work in violation of a Stop Work Order, shall be subject to fines as set forth in Chapter 2, Village Government, Article X, Fines and Penalties, Section 2.1002, Fines and Penalties Schedule, for each offense. Each day that a violation continues shall be a separate offense.

SECTION 28: The Mettawa Code of Ordinances, Chapter 10, Signs, Article VII, Enforcement, Section 10.702, Penalty, Subsections A.2. and B.2. are hereby amended and as amended shall read as follows:

SECTION 10.702 Penalty

Any person, firm, corporation, or agent, employees, contractors, or owners who violate, disobey, omit, neglect, refuse to comply with, or who resist enforcement of any of the provisions of this Chapter shall be subject to a fine as set forth in Chapter 2, Village Government, Article X, Fines and Penalties, Section 2.1002, Fines and Penalties Schedule, for each offense. For purposes of this Chapter, each day that a violation is permitted to exist shall constitute a separate offense.

SECTION 29: The Mettawa Code of Ordinances, Chapter 11, Health and Sanitation; Recapture, Article III, Regulations of the Collection of Solid Waste, Section 11.308, Declaration of Nuisances-Penalty, Subsection F is hereby amended and as amended shall read as follows:

SECTION 11.308 Declaration of Nuisances-Penalty

F. Any person, firm or corporation found guilty by a court of competent jurisdiction of any violation set forth in this Article shall be liable for payment of a fine as set forth in Chapter 2, Village Government, Article X, Fines and Penalties, Section 2.1002, Fines and Penalties Schedule, for each offense. Each day that a violation continues shall be a separate offense.

SECTION 30: The Mettawa Code of Ordinances, Chapter 11, Health and Sanitation; Recapture, Article VI, Violations, Section 11.601, Penalties, Subsections B. and C. are hereby amended and as amended shall read as follows:

SECTION 11.601 Penalties

B. Any such person, firm or corporation found guilty by a court of competent jurisdiction of any violation set forth in Subsection A above shall be liable for payment of a fine as set forth in Chapter 2, Village Government, Article X, Fines and Penalties, Section 2.1002, Fines and Penalties Schedule. Each day that a violation continues shall be deemed a separate offense.

C. Any person who shall continue any work after having been served with a Stop Work Order, except such work as that person is directed to perform to remove a violation or unsafe condition, shall be subject to fines as set forth in Chapter 2, Village Government, Article X, Fines and Penalties, Section 2.1002, Fines and Penalties Schedule, for each offense. Each day that a violation continues shall be deemed a separate offense.

SECTION 31: The Mettawa Code of Ordinances, Chapter 16, Subdivision Regulations, Article V., Enforcement, Section 16.506, Penalty, Subsection B. is hereby amended and as amended shall read as follows:

SECTION 16.506 Penalty

B. Any such person, firm or corporation upon conviction of a violation of Subsection A of this Section 16.506, shall be fined in an amount as set forth in Chapter 2, Village Government, Article X, Fines and Penalties, Section 2.1002, Fines and Penalties Schedule. Each day that such connection exists in contravention of this Section shall be a separate violation. The Village shall have the right without further notice or permission to remove all such connections so made.

SECTION 32: The Mettawa Code of Ordinances, Chapter 16, Subdivision Regulations, Article VII., Violations, Section 16.801, Penalty, Subsection B. is hereby amended and as amended shall read as follows:

SECTION 16.801 Penalty

B. Every person, firm or corporation found by a court of law to have violated any provision of this section shall be guilty of a business offense and upon conviction shall be punished by a fine as set forth in Chapter 2, Village Government, Article X, Fines and Penalties, Section 2.1002, Fines and Penalties Schedule, for each offense; and a separate offense shall be deemed to have been committed on each day during or on which a violation occurs or continues.

SECTION 33: The Mettawa Code of Ordinances, Chapter 17, Telecommunications, Article VIII., General, Section 17.108, Penalties, Subsection A. is hereby amended and as amended shall read as follows:

SECTION 17.108 Penalties

A. Any person found guilty of violating, disobeying, omitting, neglecting or refusing to comply with any of the provisions of this Chapter shall be fined in an amount as set forth in Chapter 2, Village Government, Article X, Fines and Penalties, Section 2.1002, Fines and Penalties Schedule.

SECTION 34: The Mettawa Code of Ordinances, Chapter 18, Alcoholic Beverages, Article IV., Regulation of Sales, Section 18.407, Individual Under Age, Subsection D. is hereby amended and as amended shall read as follows:

D. In every premises in the Village where alcoholic liquor is sold, there shall be displayed at all times in a prominent place a printed card which shall be supplied by the Local Liquor Control Commission and which shall read substantially as follows:

"WARNING TO MINORS

You are subject to a fine under the ordinances of the Village of Mettawa if you purchase any alcoholic liquor or misrepresent your age for the purpose of purchasing or obtaining any alcoholic liquor."

SECTION 35: The Mettawa Code of Ordinances, Chapter 18, Alcoholic Beverages, Article V., Revocation and Suspension of Licenses, Section 18.504, Penalties Following Hearing Before the Local Liquor Control Commissioner, Subsection A.1. is hereby amended and as amended shall read as follows:

SECTION 18.504 Penalties Following Hearing Before the Local Liquor Control Commissioner

A.1. If the Local Liquor Control Commissioner elects to fine such licensee in lieu of bond forfeiture, the amount of such fine shall be as set forth in Chapter 2, Village Government, Article X, Fines and Penalties, Section 2.1002, Fines and Penalties Schedule.

SECTION 36: The Mettawa Code of Ordinances, Chapter 18, Alcoholic Beverages, Article VI., Violations and Penalties, Section 18.601, Penalties and Misdemeanor, Subsections C. and D. are hereby amended and as amended shall read as follows:

SECTION 18.601

C. Every person convicted of a misdemeanor for a violation of any of the provisions of this Chapter shall be punished by a fine as set forth in Chapter 2, Village Government, Article X, Fines and Penalties, Section 2.1002, Fines and Penalties Schedule, for each offense, and a separate offense shall be deemed to have been committed on each day during or on which a violation occurs or continues. Every act or omission of whatsoever nature constituting a violation of any of the provisions of this Chapter, by any officer, director, manager or other agent or employee of any licensee, shall be deemed and held to be the act of such employer or licensee, and said employer or licensee shall be punishable in the same manner as if said act or omission had been done by him personally.

D. Any individual under the age of twenty-one (21) who presents or offers to any licensee, his agent or employee, any written, printed or photostatic evidence of age and identity which is false, fraudulent, or not actually his own for the purpose of ordering, purchasing, attempting to purchase, or otherwise procuring or attempting to procure the serving of any alcoholic beverage, or who has in his possession any false or fraudulent written, printed, or photostatic evidence of age and identity, upon conviction thereof by a court of law shall be fined as set forth in Chapter 2, Village Government, Article X, Fines and Penalties, Section 2.1002, Fines and Penalties Schedule.

SECTION 37: The Mettawa Code of Ordinances, Chapter 19, Taxation, Article I., Hotel-Motel Tax, Section 19.106, Penalty, Subsection B. is hereby amended and as amended shall read as follows:

SECTION 19.106 Penalty

B. Any person, firm, or corporation convicted of a misdemeanor for a violation of any of the provisions of this Article shall be punished by a fine as set forth in Chapter 2, Village Government, Article X, Fines and Penalties, Section 2.1002, Fines and Penalties Schedule, and a separate offense shall be deemed to have been committed on each day during or on which a violation occurs or continues.

SECTION 38: The Mettawa Code of Ordinances, Chapter 19, Taxation, Article II., Real Estate Transfer Tax, Section 19.209, Penalty Tax Violation, Subsections A. and B. are hereby amended and as amended shall read as follows:

SECTION 19.209 Penalty for Violation

A. In addition to the other provisions hereunder, any person found guilty in a court of competent jurisdiction of violating, disobeying, neglecting, or refusing to comply with or resisting or opposing the enforcement of any provision hereof shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction thereof, shall be punished by a fine as set forth in Chapter 2, Village Government, Article X, Fines and Penalties, Section 2.1002, Fines and Penalties Schedule.

B. In addition to the above and foregoing, any person who willfully falsifies the value of the transferred real estate on the declaration of value required by Section 19.202 or who willfully falsifies or willfully omits any other information required by this subchapter or who willfully and falsely claims a transaction to be exempt under Section 19.205 thereof, shall be punished by a fine as set forth in Chapter 2, Village Government, Article X, Fines and Penalties, Section 2.1002, Fines and Penalties Schedule.

SECTION 39: The Mettawa Code of Ordinances, Chapter 20, Article IV., Violations, Section 20.104, General Penalty; Supervision, Subsection A. is hereby amended and as amended shall read as follows:

SECTION 20.104 General Penalty; Supervision

A. Whenever in this Code, or in any ordinance of the Village, any act or omission is prohibited or is made or declared to be unlawful or a misdemeanor, or whenever in such Code or ordinance the doing of any act or the omission of a required act is declared to be unlawful or a misdemeanor, where no specific penalty is provided therefor, and State law does not provide otherwise, the violation of any such provision of this Code or such ordinance shall be a misdemeanor punishable by a fine as set forth in Chapter 2, Village Government, Article X, Fines and Penalties, Section 2.1002, Fines and Penalties Schedule. Unless specifically provided otherwise, each day that any such violation exists shall constitute a separate offense.

F. Application Fees. Unless otherwise provided by franchise, license, or similar agreement, all applications for permits pursuant to this Chapter shall be accompanied by a fee in the amount set forth in Chapter 2, Village Government, Article X, Fees, Fines and Penalties, Section 2.1001, Fees. No application fee is required to be paid by any electricity utility that is paying the municipal electricity infrastructure maintenance fee pursuant to the Electricity Infrastructure Maintenance Fee Act.

SECTION 41: The Mettawa Code of Ordinances, Chapter 5, Streets and Parks, Article III., Driveways, Section 5.307, Permit Fees, is hereby amended and as amended shall read as follows:

SECTION 5.307 Permit Fees

For all new driveway approach construction, upon issuance of a driveway or curb change permit, the applicant shall pay to the Village Clerk or Village Collector permit and inspection fees in the amount set forth in Chapter 2, Village Government, Article X, Fees, Fines and Penalties, Section 2.1001, Fees.

SECTION 42: The Mettawa Code of Ordinances, Chapter 5, Streets and Parks, Article IV., Restoration of Village Owned Land, Section 5.402, Permits, Subsection B.2. and Section 5.403 Subsections A. are hereby amended and as amended shall read as follows:

SECTION 5.402 Permits

B.2. At any time prior to its becoming void, a permit may be extended for one (1) year for an additional fee as set forth in Chapter 2, Village Government, Article X, Fees, Fines and Penalties, Section 2.1001, Fees, but in no case shall the fee be less than the minimum fee specified on the most recent fee schedule approved by the President and Board of Trustees. Permits may be extended for two (2) six (6) month periods by the Village Engineer if Work has been delayed due to the large size of the project, shortage of materials, or due to inclement weather conditions.

SECTION 5.403 Permit Fees and Financial Responsibility

A. Fee. Each Application shall be accompanied by a Permit fee in the amount set forth in Chapter 2, Village Government, Article X, Fees, Fines and Penalties, Section 2.1001, Fees.

SECTION 43: The Mettawa Code of Ordinances, Chapter 5, Streets and Parks, Article VI., Small Wireless Facilities, Section 5.605, Permits; Application Process, Subsection D. is hereby amended and as amended shall read as follows:

SECTION 5.605 Permits; Application Process

D. Permit Application Fees: All applications for collocation of small wireless facilities shall be accompanied by a nonrefundable application fee in the amount set forth in Chapter 2, Village Government, Article X, Fees, Fines and Penalties, Section 2.1001, Fees.

SECTION 44: The Mettawa Code of Ordinances, Chapter 5, Streets and Parks, Article VI., Small Wireless Facilities, Section 5.613, Collocation on Village Owned Infrastructure, Subsection A. is hereby amended and as amended shall read as follows:

SECTION 5.613 Collocation on Village Owned Infrastructure

A. Fee: The annual fee to collocate a small wireless facility on a Village-owned utility pole located in a right-of-way shall be the higher of the amount set forth in Chapter 2, Village Government, Article X, Fees, Fines and Penalties, Section 2.1001, Fees, or the actual, direct, and reasonable costs related to the wireless providers use of space on the pole.

SECTION 45: The Mettawa Code of Ordinances, Chapter 6, Traffic, Article XIII., Stopping, Standing and Parking, Section 16.1308, Handicapped Persons; Parking and Exemptions, Subsection B.2. is hereby amended and as amended shall read as follows:

SECTION 16.1308

B.2. The Village shall be responsible for the provision of such decal or device, its issuance and designated placement within the vehicle. The cost of such decal or device shall be in the amount set forth in Chapter 2, Village Government, Article X, Fees, Fines and Penalties, Section 2.1001, Fees.

SECTION 46: The Mettawa Code of Ordinances, Chapter 7, Offenses and Miscellaneous Regulations, Article VII., Solicitors and Canvassers, Section 7.708, Issuance or Denial of Certificate of Registration, Subsection A.2. is hereby amended and as amended shall read as follows:

SECTION 7.708 Issuance or Denial of Certificate of Registration

A.2. Upon receipt of the certificate of registration, the applicant shall deposit the amount set forth in Chapter 2, Village Government, Article X, Fees, Fines and Penalties, Section 2.1001, Fees, with the Village Administrator, which amount shall be refunded at the time the certificate of registration is returned intact, excluding reasonable wear and tear; provided the return is made not later than five (5) days after the date of expiration of said certificate.

SECTION 47: The Mettawa Code of Ordinances, Chapter 7, Offenses and Miscellaneous Regulations, Article VIII., Mandates Under the Illinois Freedom of Information Act and the Illinois Open Meetings Act, Section 7.805, Fees, is hereby amended and as amended shall read as follows:

SECTION 7.805 Fees

Except as otherwise provided by applicable statute, the Freedom of Information Officer shall charge the fees for the copying of documents as set forth in Chapter 2, Village Government, Article X, Fees, Fines and Penalties, Section 2.1001, Fees.

SECTION 48: The Mettawa Code of Ordinances, Chapter 8, Private Individual Onsite Sewage Disposal Systems, Article VI., Site Suitability, Section 8.606, Procedures and Fees, is hereby amended and as amended shall read as follows:

SECTION 8.606 Procedures and Fees

Administrative procedure and fees relative to this Chapter shall be as set forth in Chapter 2, Village Government, Article X, Fees, Fines and Penalties, Section 2.1001, Fees.

SECTION 49: The Mettawa Code of Ordinances, Chapter 9, Building Code, Article I., Administration and Enforcement, Section 9.116, Fees, Subsection C. and D., are hereby amended and as amended shall read as follows:

SECTION 9.116 Fees

C. Fees: The following shall apply to all new construction and to all remodeling of all buildings in the Village of Mettawa:

1. All plan review and Building Permit fees shall be paid in accordance with Chapter 2, Village Government, Article X, Fees, Fines and Penalties, Section 2.1001, Fees.

a. Prior to the issuance of a Building Permit for any new construction or remodeling, the owner, contractor or representative shall pay to the Village the Building Permit fee.

b. The funds thus collected shall be used by the Village for its general corporate purposes, with primary application being the necessary costs to review plans, enforce the zoning ordinance and building code, issue permits, and inspect construction.

c. The above described fees may be increased or decreased at the discretion of the President and Board of Trustees.

2. Plan Review Fee. A plan review fee shall be paid to the Village at the time of submittal of any plan for review and shall be as set forth in Chapter 2, Village Government, Article X, Fees, Fines and Penalties, Section 2.1001, Fees.

3. Other Fees. Driveway permit fees, storm sewer permit fees, public property protection fees, permit renewal fees, removal of stop work order fees, building permit placard replacement

fees, building permit plans replacement fees, partial occupancy permit fees, late permit fees, and Building Code Board of Appeals Application fees shall be as set forth in Chapter 2, Village Government, Article X, Fees, Fines and Penalties, Section 2.1001, Fees.

4. Reinspection Fees. A reinspection fee in the greater amount of the fee set forth in Chapter 2, Village Government, Article X, Fees, Fines and Penalties, Section 2.1001, Fees, or the amount adequate to reimburse the Village for additional expense incurred, shall be charged on any construction work which through negligence, improper calls for inspections, incomplete work or poor workmanship on the part of the contractor, makes it necessary for the inspector to make more than two inspections of a single phase of construction.

D. Special Fees:

1. The payment of the fee for the construction, alteration, removal or demolition and for all work done in connection with or concurrently with the work contemplated by a Building Permit shall not relieve the applicant or holder of the permit from the payment of other fees that may be set forth in Chapter 2, Village Government, Article X, Fees, Fines and Penalties, Section 2.1001, Fees, or prescribed by statute, resolution or other ordinance requirements.

2. An additional fee as set forth in Chapter 2, Village Government, Article X, Fees, Fines and Penalties, Section 2.1001, Fees, shall be required for all new construction projects and all additions to existing buildings.

a. The fee is to assure the replacement, repair, cleaning or restoration of public property, damaged or littered by the contractor or the subcontractors, in the prosecution of the work for which the permit was issued.

b. If the public property is damaged or littered, the Contractor shall be notified to take necessary action to restore the public property to its original condition.

c. In the event the public property is so repaired by the contractor and approved by the Building Administrator or his designee, ninety percent (90%) of the fee shall be returned to the depositor; otherwise the Village shall use the fee to repair or clear the public property.

SECTION 50: The Mettawa Code of Ordinances, Chapter 11, Health and Sanitation, Article II., Private Irrigation Water Wells, Section 11.202, Inspections and Fees, Subsection A. is hereby amended and as amended shall read as follows:

SECTION 11.202 Inspections and Fees

A. The permit fee for the construction and installation of a private irrigation water well and installation of the appurtenant irrigation system shall in the amount set forth in Chapter 2, Village Government, Article X, Fees, Fines and Penalties, Section 2.1001, Fees.

1. This fee shall include the fee for plan review and inspection of the construction.

2. The permit fee for the construction of an irrigation system only shall be in the amount as set forth in Chapter 2, Village Government, Article X, Fees, Fines and Penalties, Section 2.1001, Fees.

SECTION 51: The Mettawa Code of Ordinances, Chapter 11, Health and Sanitation, Article III., Regulations of the Collections of Solid Waste, Section 11.303, License Fee; Issuance of License, Subsection A. is hereby amended and as amended shall read as follows:

SECTION 11.303 License Fee; Issuance of License

A. The annual license fee shall be in the amount set forth in Chapter 2, Village Government, Article X, Fees, Fines and Penalties, Section 2.1001, Fees.

SECTION 52: The Mettawa Code of Ordinances, Chapter 17, Telecommunications, Article II., Registration of Telecommunications Carriers and Providers, Section 17.202, Registration Fee, is hereby amended and as amended shall read as follows:

SECTION 17.202 Registration Fee

Each application for registration as a telecommunications carrier or provider shall be accompanied by a fee as set forth in Chapter 2, Village Government, Article X, Fees, Fines and Penalties, Section 2.1001, Fees.

SECTION 53: The Mettawa Code of Ordinances, Chapter 17, Telecommunications, Article VI., Fees and Compensation, Section 17.602, Application and Review Fee, Subsection A, and B.1. are hereby amended and as amended shall read as follows:

SECTION 17.602 Applications and Review Fee

A. Any applicant for a license or franchise pursuant to Articles III or IV of this Chapter shall pay a fee in the amount set forth in Chapter 2, Village Government, Article X, Fees, Fines and Penalties, Section 2.1001, Fees.

B.1. The amount set forth in Chapter 2, Village Government, Article X, Fees, Fines and Penalties, Section 2.1001, Fees; and

SECTION 54: The Mettawa Code of Ordinances, Chapter 17, Telecommunications, Article VI., Fees and Compensation, Section 17.606, Construction Permit Fee, is hereby amended and as amended shall read as follows:

SECTION 17.606 Construction Permit Fee

Prior to issuance of a construction permit, the permittee shall pay a permit fee in the amount set forth in Chapter 2, Village Government, Article X, Fees, Fines and Penalties, Section 2.1001, Fees, or .5% of the estimated cost of constructing the telecommunication facilities, as certified by the applicant's engineer and approved by the Village Engineer, whichever is greater.

SECTION 55: The Mettawa Code of Ordinances, Chapter 17, Telecommunications, Article VI., Fees and Compensation, Section 17.607, Annual Fees, is hereby amended and as amended shall read as follows:

SECTION 17.607 Annual Fees

Unless otherwise agreed in a license or franchise grant agreement, each license or franchise grantee shall pay an annual license fee to the Village in the amount as set forth in Chapter 2, Village Government, Article X, Fees, Fines and Penalties, Section 2.1001, Fees, as reimbursement for the Village's costs in connection with reviewing, inspecting and supervising the use and occupancy of the public ways on behalf of the public and existing or future users.

SECTION 56: The Mettawa Code of Ordinances, Chapter 17, Telecommunications, Article IX., Cable/Video Service Provider, Section 17.901, Cable/Video Service Provider Fee Imposed, is hereby amended and as amended shall read as follows:

SECTION 17.901 Cable/Video Service Provider Fee Imposed

A fee in an amount set forth in Chapter 2, Village Government, Article X, Fees, Fines and Penalties, Section 2.1001, Fees, is imposed hereby on any holder providing cable service or video service within the corporate limits of the Village.

A. In accordance with and pursuant to 220 ILCS 5/21-401(b)(6), each holder shall forward an application notice to the Village Clerk at least ten (10) days prior to the date on which the holder begins to offer cable service or video service within the corporate limits of the Village.

B. Upon receipt of the notice required in Subsection A, the Village Clerk shall mail to the address listed on the holder's application notice a certified copy of the Ordinance adopting this Section.

C. The fee hereby imposed does not apply to existing cable service or video service providers that have an existing franchise agreement with the Village in which a fee is paid.

SECTION 57: The Mettawa Code of Ordinances, Chapter 17, Telecommunications, Article IX., Cable/Video Service Provider, Section 17.902, PEG Access Support Fee Imposed, is hereby amended and as amended shall read as follows:

SECTION 17.902 PEG Access Support Fee Imposed

In addition to the fee imposed pursuant to Section 17.901, PEG access support fee in the amount set forth in Chapter 2, Village Government, Article X, Fees, Fines and Penalties, Section 2.1001, Fees, is imposed hereby on any holder providing cable service or video service within the corporate limits of the Village.

SECTION 58: The Mettawa Code of Ordinances, Chapter 18, Alcoholic Beverages, Article III., Licenses, Section 18.302, Application for License, Subsection C.2., is hereby amended and as amended shall read as follows:

SECTION 18.302 Application for License

C.2. The applicant shall see to it that the names of all bartenders, managers, all principals, the applicant (in the case of an individual), all partners and (in the case of a corporation) all officers and all stockholders owning an aggregate of more than five percent (5%) of the stock of such corporation are submitted to the Lake County Sheriff's Police Department and that all of the aforesaid individuals submit themselves for fingerprinting by the said Lake County Sheriff's Police Department along with a fee in the amount set forth in Chapter 2, Village Government, Article X, Fees, Fines and Penalties, Section 2.1001, Fees, for each set of fingerprints to be taken, in order that the said Lake County Sheriff's Police Department may perform adequate investigation of such individuals to enable the Local Liquor Control Commission to ascertain that issuance of any such license will comply with the statutes of the State of Illinois and all applicable ordinances of the Village.

SECTION 59: The Mettawa Code of Ordinances, Chapter 18, Alcoholic Beverages, Article III., Licenses, Section 18.306, License Fees, Subsection A. is hereby amended and as amended shall read as follows:
